

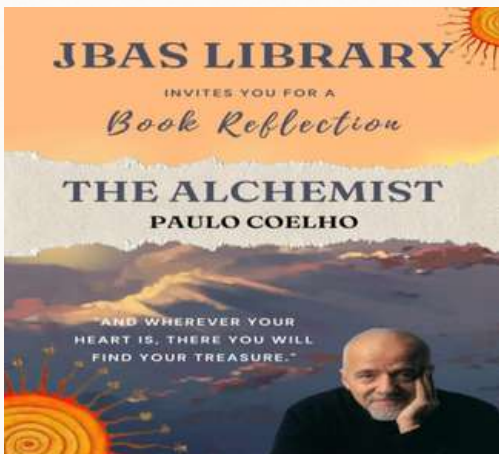


CENTRAL LIBRARY




THERE IS A WORLD BEYOND STARS
