

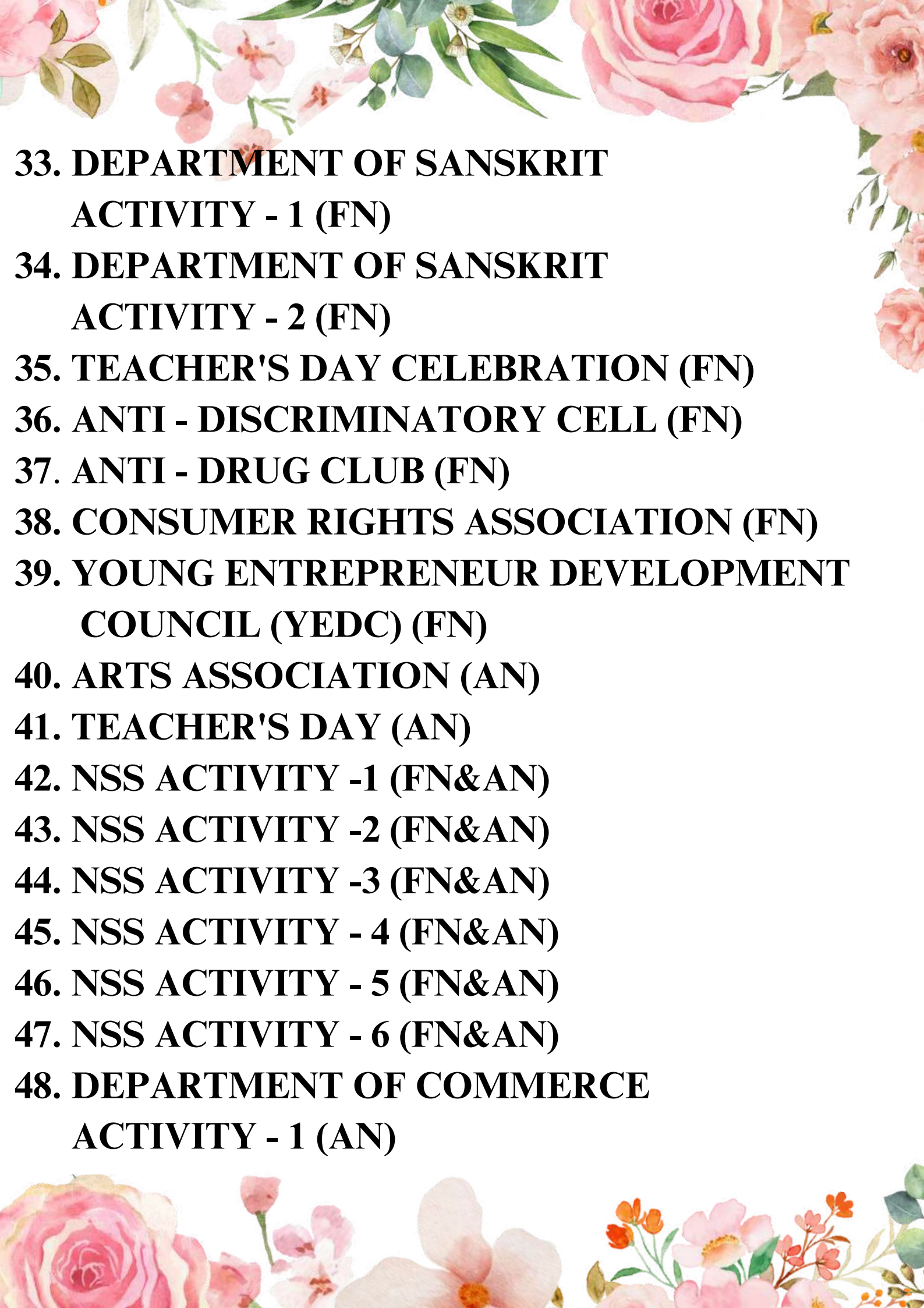


Just Bliss 24

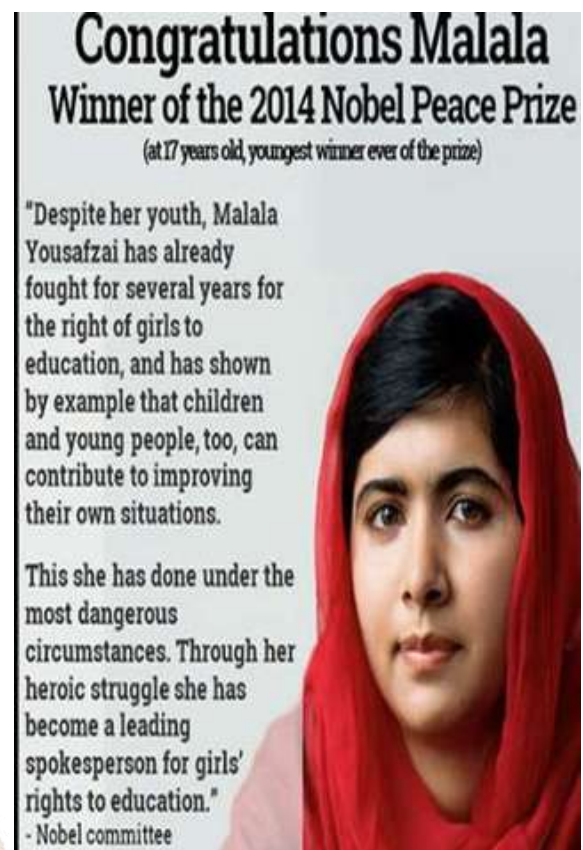
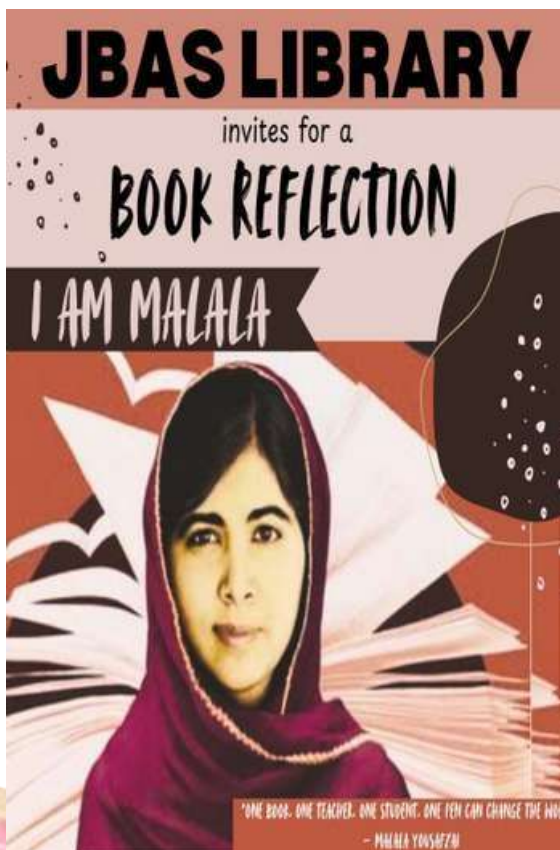
The NDLI book lover's club from the central Library conducted an online reading habit promotion activity from 23rd September 2024 to 30th September 2024.

DEPARTMENT OF PG STUDIES AND RESEARCH IN HOME SCIENCE

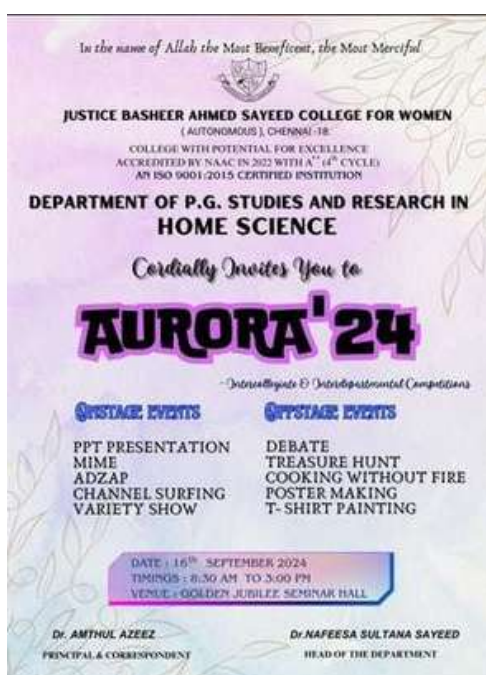

National Nutrition Month (September 2024) - Health Camp

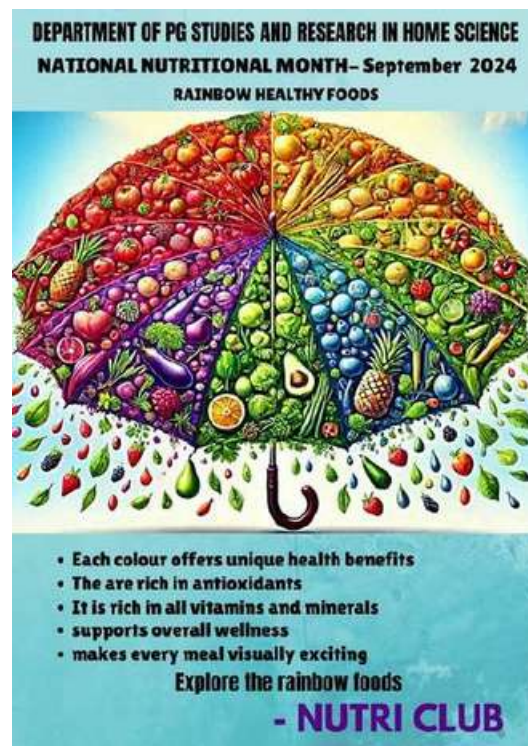

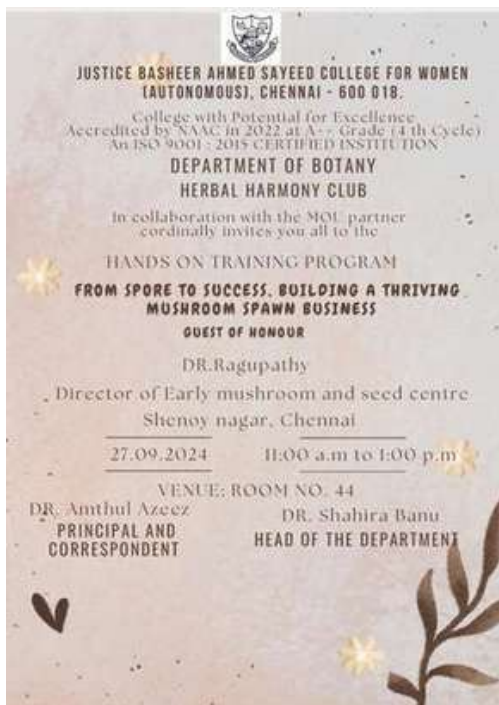


ANTI-DISCRIMINATORY CELL

The Arts Association was held on 6th September 2024 which was organized by the Departments of Economics, English and Tourism and Travel Management at the Golden Jubilee Seminar Hall at 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm. The guest of honour, Sara Kachwalla, a facilitator, life coach, behavioural trainer and psychologist, delivered the inaugural address on Mental Well-Being. The event began with a prayer recited by Ms. Zakia from M.A. Economics, followed by the welcome address by Ms. Safia. A box of dry fruits was presented to the guest by the Vice Principal as a gesture of appreciation.

Ms. Sara Kachwalla began her address, focusing on the topic of mental well-being. She spoke with great insight, covering the three main aspects of thoughts, emotions, breath, and engaging the audience with practical exercises and reflective questions. She explained that stress is not a disease, but rather a disease for the body.

She first discussed thoughts, highlighting that the average person has around 50,000 to 60,000 thoughts a day, with 90% of them being self induced, often focused on past worries or regrets. She encouraged the audience to take control of their thought processes, asking themselves, “What do I really want?” and refraining from complaints, criticisms, or excuses. She explained how consistently thinking positively can reshape the brain's behaviour, fostering a happier and more fulfilled life.





Ms. Kachwalla then spoke about emotions, revealing that there are 256 different emotions that we experience daily. She emphasized that no emotion is inherently negative and that every emotion, even anger, serves a purpose in helping us respond to situations. She stressed the importance of understanding and managing emotions from a young age and urged everyone to acknowledge their feelings instead of suppressing them.

The final aspect of her talk centred on breath. Ms. Kachwalla explained that our breath is a key tool in managing both thoughts and emotions. She led the audience through an exercise to measure their breathing rate, explaining that fewer than 15 breaths per minute indicates a low stress level, while more than 20 breaths per minute suggests higher stress. She emphasized that controlled breathing can significantly improve mental clarity and emotional balance.





By the end of her address, the audience felt enlightened by her words and the practical strategies she shared left a lasting impact on everyone present. Ms. Kachwalla concluded her address with an activity on gratitude, asking participants to reflect on five things they were grateful for, which she explained could shift one's mind set toward positivity.



The session was interactive, with Ms. Kachwalla posing questions to the audience and engaging in a 10-minute Q&A segment. Students asked about the practical application of positive thinking and managing stress in daily life, to which she provided insightful responses.





Following the Chief Guest's address, the event transitioned into cultural performances. Vaishnavi, a student from the Department of Tourism and Travel Management, presented a Bharatanatyam dance, was a beautiful and graceful display of traditional art.

Her precise movements and expressions captivated the audience, and the applause she received reflected the admiration everyone felt. It was truly a mesmerizing performance that left a lasting impression.

Followed by a humorous play, Uncle Podger Hangs a Picture, performed by third-year students from the English Department was filled with humour and wit. The students brought the characters to life with their impeccable timing and acting, making the audience laugh throughout. It was a light-hearted, fun performance that everyone thoroughly enjoyed, showcasing the students' talent in drama.

The Department of Economics contributed with two thoughtful dramas highlighting the importance of mental well-being, particularly addressing suicide prevention and the impact of parental neglect. The performance was both powerful and thought-provoking, leaving the audience deeply moved. The students skilfully conveyed the message, making the play a memorable and impactful experience.





The cultural program as a whole was a delightful and enjoyable experience, with both the audience and the guest of honour, Ms. Sara Kachwala, thoroughly appreciating every moment. She expressed her admiration for the students' efforts and mentioned how much she enjoyed the performances, stating that she had a wonderful time with us. The HOD of the Department of English presented a memento to the guest of honour, Ms. Sara Kachwala, as a token of appreciation for her insightful and engaging address. 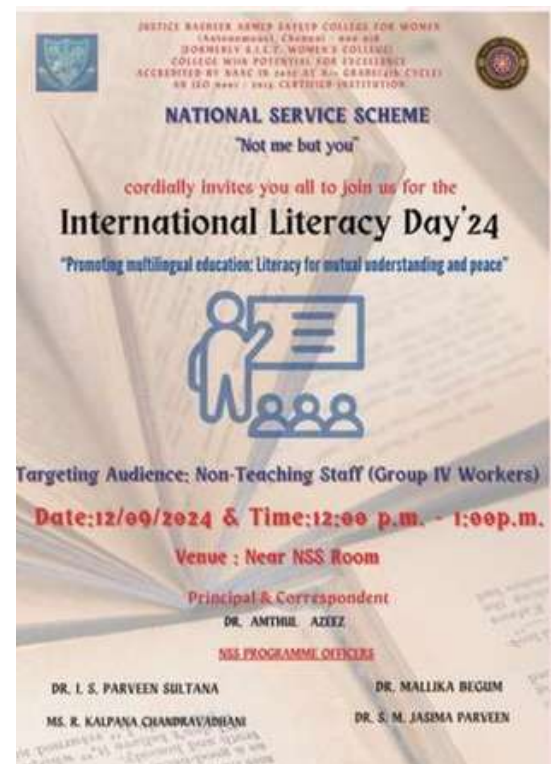




NSS ACTIVITIES (F.N&A.N.)

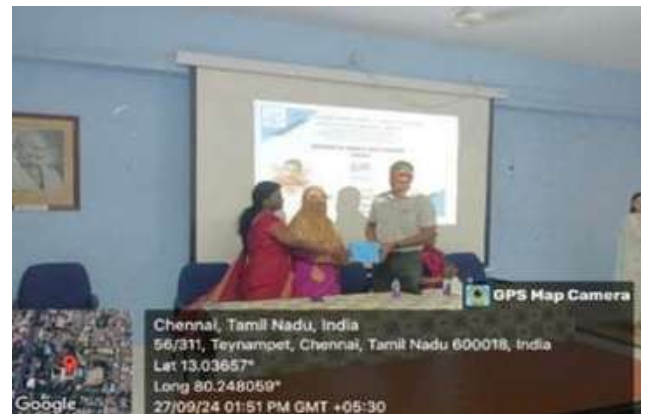


The celebration featured engaging inter-departmental competitions designed to showcase students' creativity and fostering collaboration and innovative thinking.

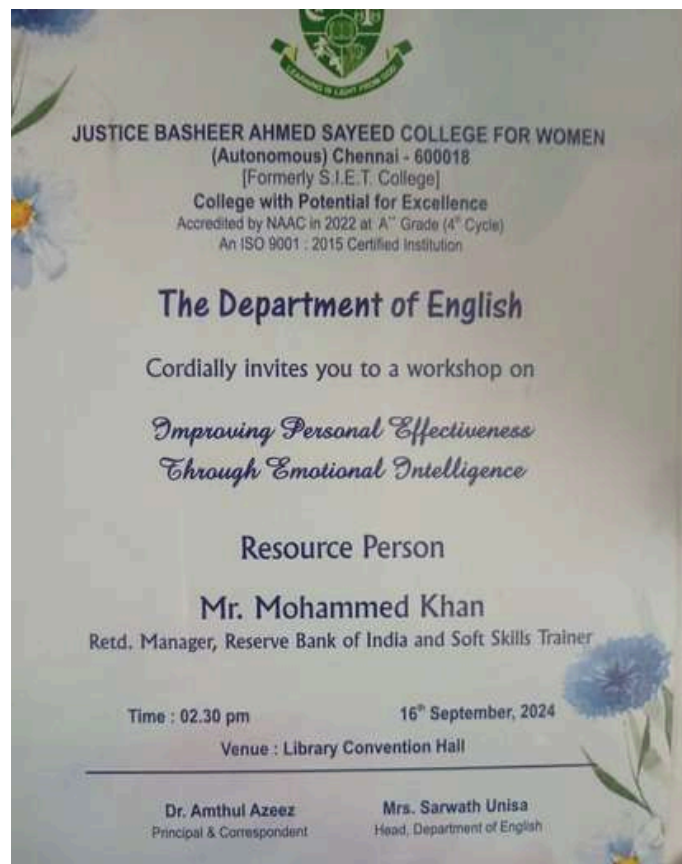




DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH (A.N.)

He also talked about the importance of Reserve Bank Of India and how it operates. For the students who were interested in working in Reserve Bank Of India, he gave certain guidelines for them.



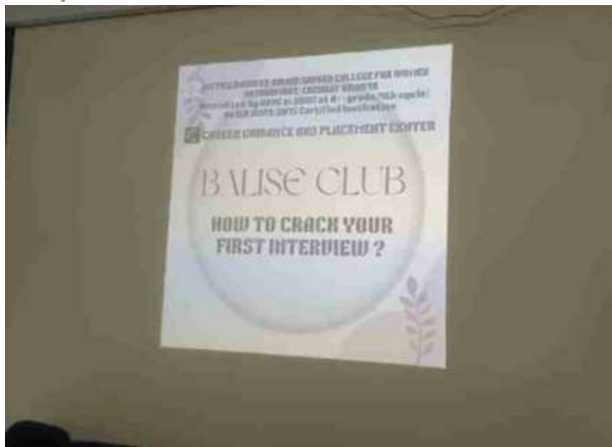


CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CENTRE (F.N. & A.N.)

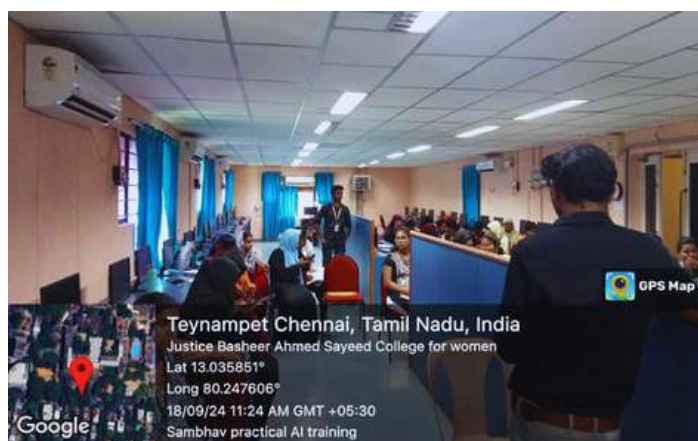
