- Computers and associated facilities for smooth functioning of office.

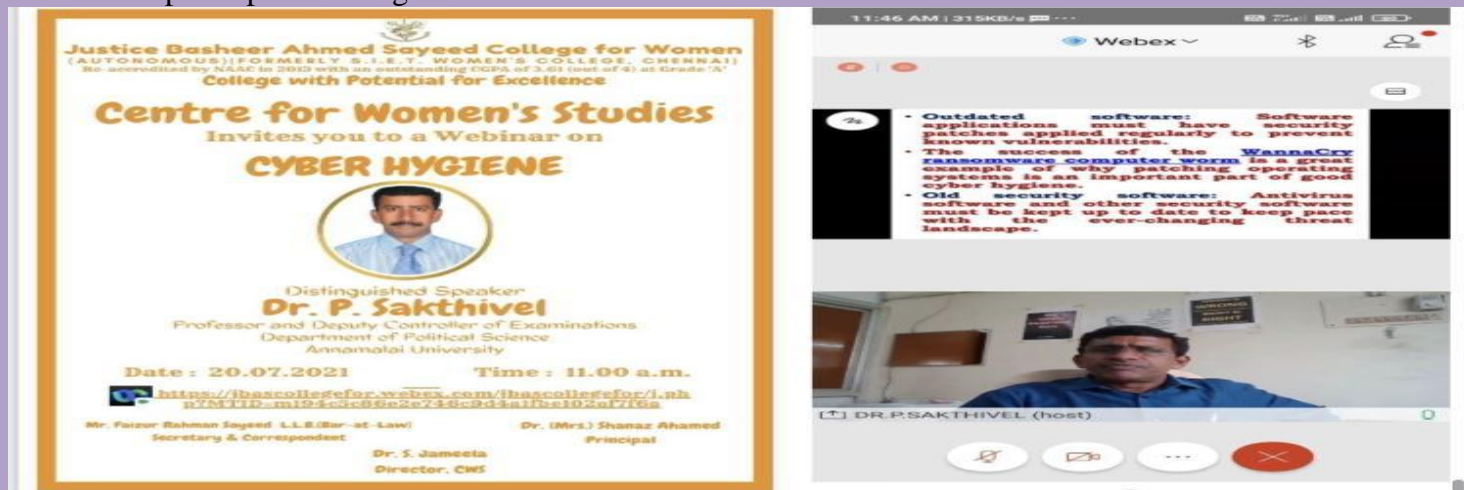
TEACHING PROGRAMMES OFFERED:
