### **(Career Guidance and Placement Unit)**


The Career guidance and placement unit of our college has conducted a job fair and various campus drives this month, in order to develop the students future. As the phrase goes start with a step, the drive started

with an Aptitude test followed by communication and technical and to end with the HR round basically the pre interview.

The companies which showed up to our campus are:

### **COGNIZANT:**

The drive started at November 26<sup>th</sup> with an aptitude test conducted to over 300 students from both morning and evening shifts. On December 4<sup>th</sup>, 200 students were selected for the second round . After attending all the rounds there were 87 students being shortlisted.


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### *Companies Participating*



The placement and career guidance unit of our college also conducted a Job Fair with more than 20 companies with the support of FUEL team to give an opportunity to all those who are in need of a push by getting job .Everyone was welcomed in this job fair, more than 200 people showed up. In a maximum of 60-70 students got selected during the job fair.

We also had an executive from the Mahindra training school to explain about the training program they conduct about how to attend an interview, face the obstacles and even an approach to attend the aptitude test . Students being impressed by her speech enrolled themselves in the two month training course.

## Special Camp (NSS Unit – FN)

The camp began with the INAUGURATION FUNCTION at the Academy Hall, following breakfast.



Dr. Raja Hussain' Registrar, B. S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute Of Science And Technology was the chief guest of the event. In his inaugural address, Dr. Raja spoke about the dynamic aspects of the NSS. He highlighted the necessity of serving society through NSS and also quoted the employment opportunities available for the NSS certificate holders.

Dr. Parveen Sultana, the NSS Programme Officer, who gave the Dynamics of the Camp also spoke about the gratifying nature of NSS and reiterated the motto of NSS - "personality development through social service".

The students then gathered for an ice breaking session. The second day of the camp began with a session on Healthy Habits. Ms. Mythily, founder of the Mythiliy Clinic shared the struggles experienced by her as an entrepreneur and as a woman and how she overcame them in order to reach the

point where she is in life now. The students were inspired and encouraged to hope and fight for one's dreams.



After this, the volunteers were sent to the adopted areas in groups for the field work, where they involved themselves in collecting the data of the slum dwellers. After lunch, the students had a creative and innovative session with Dr. Shaista, H.O.D. of IDD Department, and JBAS College for Women. The students learned how to make name plates and head portraits under her guidance. Following this, the students had a session on Mosquito Awareness with Mr. Joseph, from the Health Department. Dr. Moses addressed the students then on the topic of “Stress Management”. He spoke about the different stressful situations that we face in our day to day lives and gave tips on how we can control our stress and cope with our lifestyle without compromising our health. The next day began with yoga session. Followed by that a team from the Teynampet Health Centre, Corporation of Chennai enlightened the volunteers on Tuberculosis Awareness. They distributed several flyers on TB and its symptoms.



Following this session, the students were sent to the adopted areas for the field work, where they continued their data collection work and also invited the beneficiaries to the Health Camp that was organized to be held the next day at the marriage hall near the adopted areas. Following the field visit, the students gathered and started making arrangements for the Health Camp that was being held that day. The Health Camp consisted of four different camps such as Eye Camp (Udhi Eye Hospital), Dental Camp (from Balaji Dental Clinic), General Health Camp (from Giriswari Hospital) and TB Camp (from the Corporation of Chennai). Next, the students had a session on “Women Rights” with Mr. John Danraj and an entertaining session with Mr. Sowmiyanarayan. The session ended with an impromptu debate on “freedom of women today” by the NSS Volunteers. The topic was beautifully concluded by determining that the extent of one’s freedom is directly determined by the extent of our maturity. The walkathon was organized in honour of one of the greatest poets from India, Bharathiyar. A total of 150 volunteers took part in this event.

The next programme was a session with the VLCC team. They shared with us several health tips that would help us maintain the health of our skin and hair. The final day of the special camp began with the much awaited Talent Show, where the students displayed their various talents like singing, dancing, poetry, henna and even drawing/art.

The Valedictory Function being the concluding event of the Special Camp for the year 2019-2020 began at 04.00pm. The Volunteers recited the camp song and performed stage shows. Dr. Subashini, Dean, Madras School of Social Work presided over the Valedictory Session. Several women and children along with some of the volunteers of the camp came forward to give their feedback and share their experiences with the volunteers of the camp. The vote of thanks was delivered by Gousiya Afrin, the NSS Secretary. The programme came to a grand closure with the National Anthem sung with full gusto by the Volunteers which did compete with the heavy showers of the monsoon.




