# DEPARTMENT OF APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY AND BEHAVIORAL RESEARCH



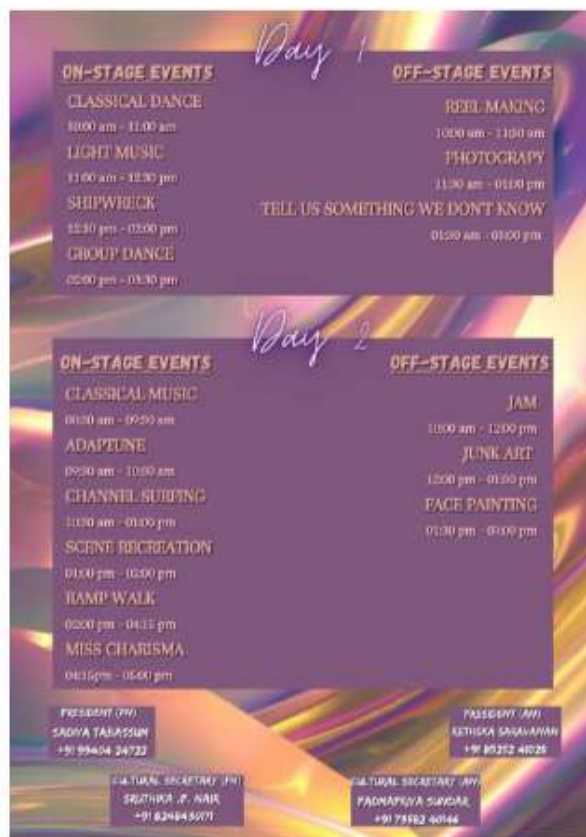

# DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY



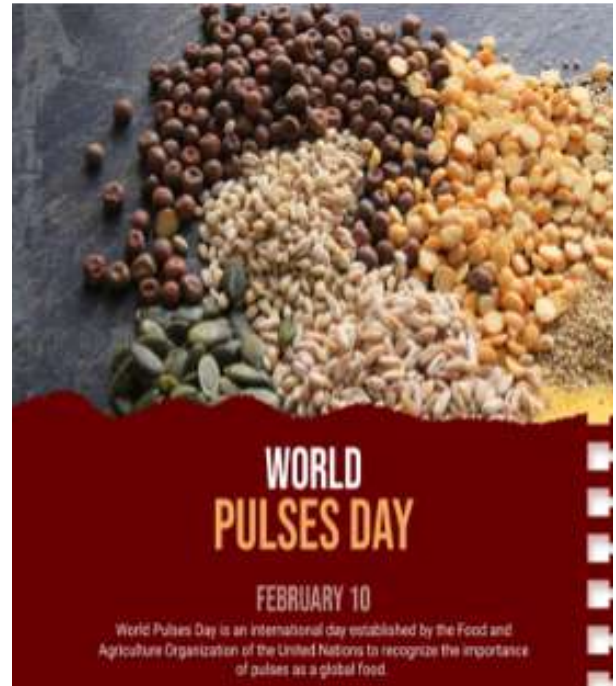

# SEMINAR CUM EXHIBITION



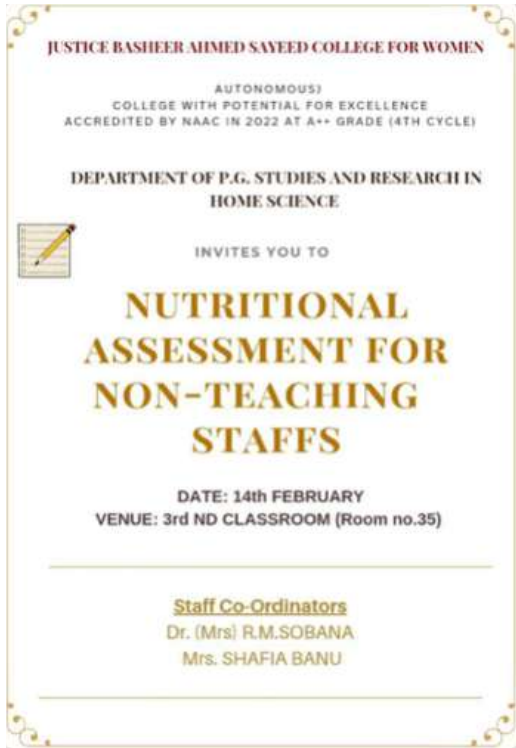

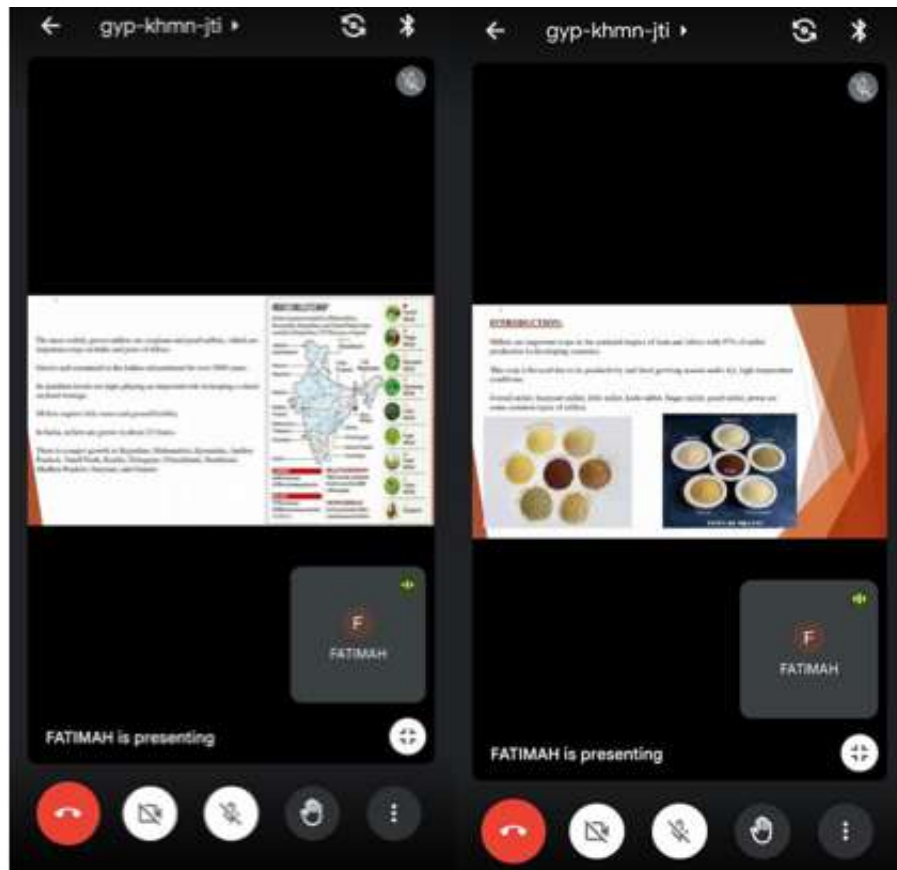

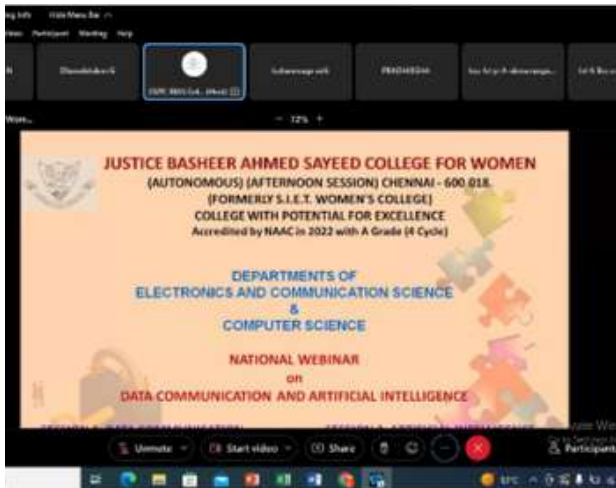


# DEPARTMENT OF HOME SCIENCE (AN)

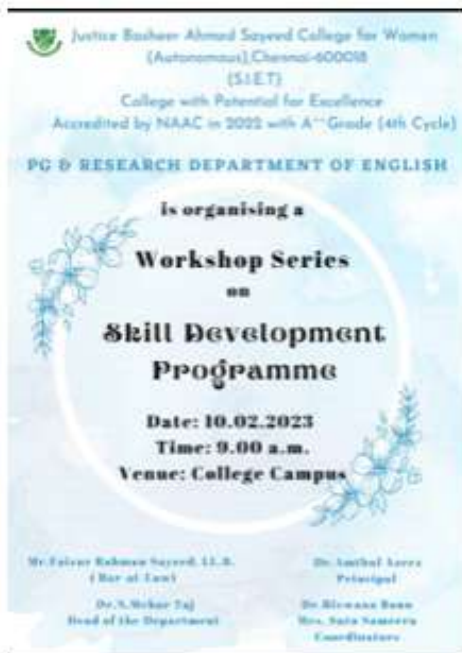

The Department of English (A.N) organised its Intra Departmental Competitions under Literary Fiesta'23 in the Library Convention Hall on the 17th of February, '2023.

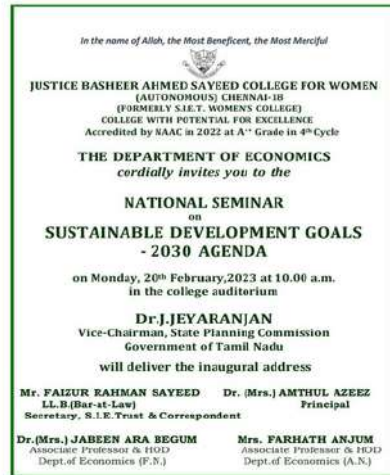
There were five events, out of which Short film, Enact and Quiz were on-stage performances, while Fix the Climax and Cake Decoration were off-stage events.

# YOUTH RED CROSS UNIT



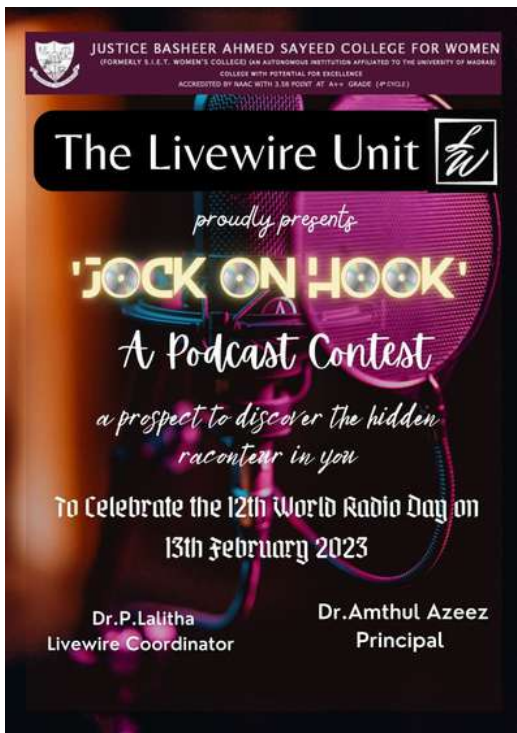

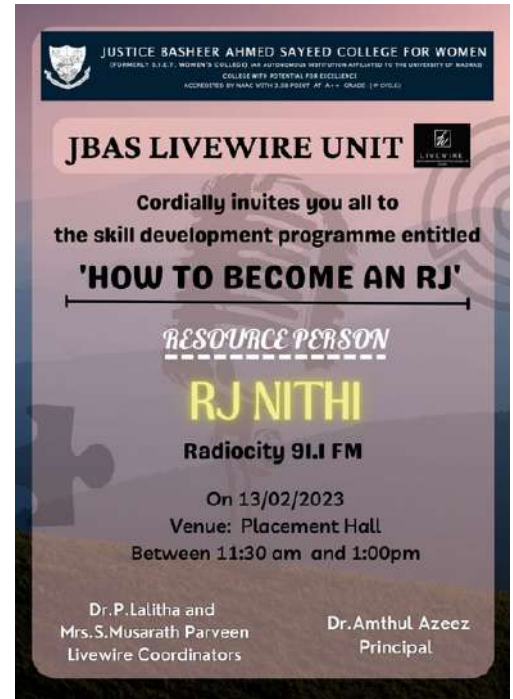

# WORDWAR AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME



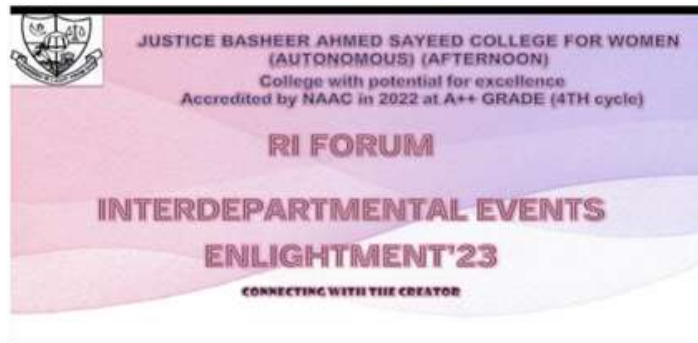

When life made me to feel

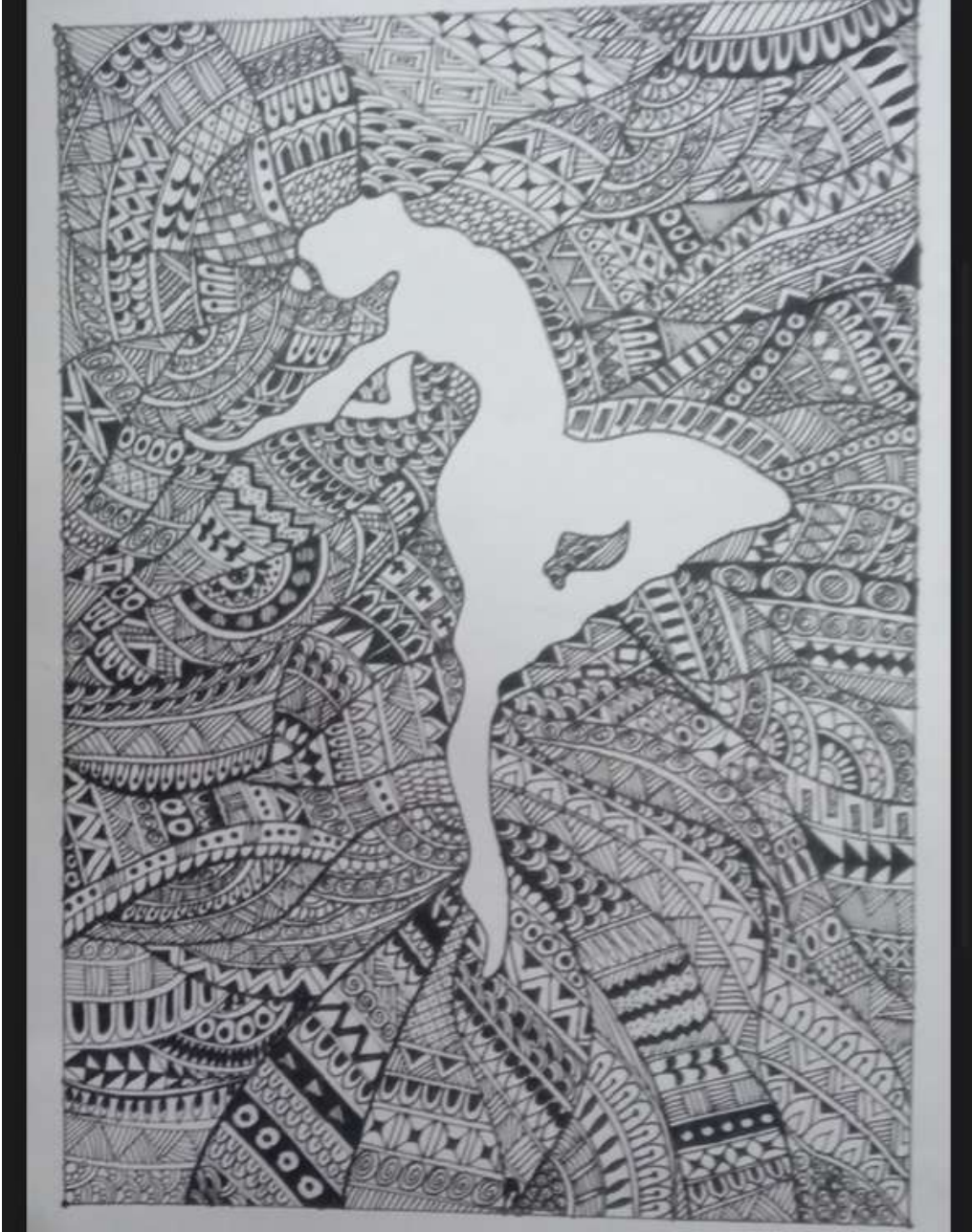
