The Department of Physics conducted an online Intra-Departmental competition on poster making, photography, cartooning and mini projects on the theme ‘Light’.

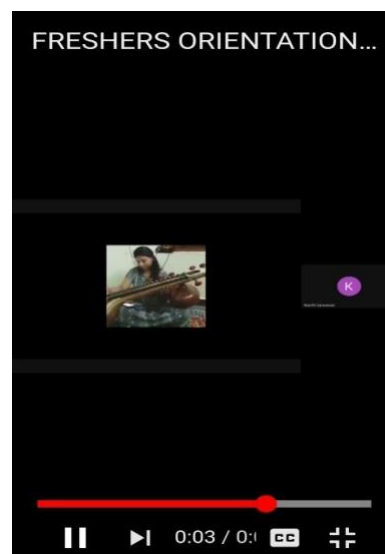
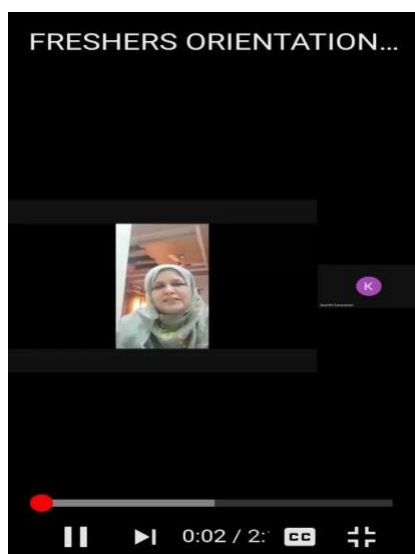
DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH (FN)

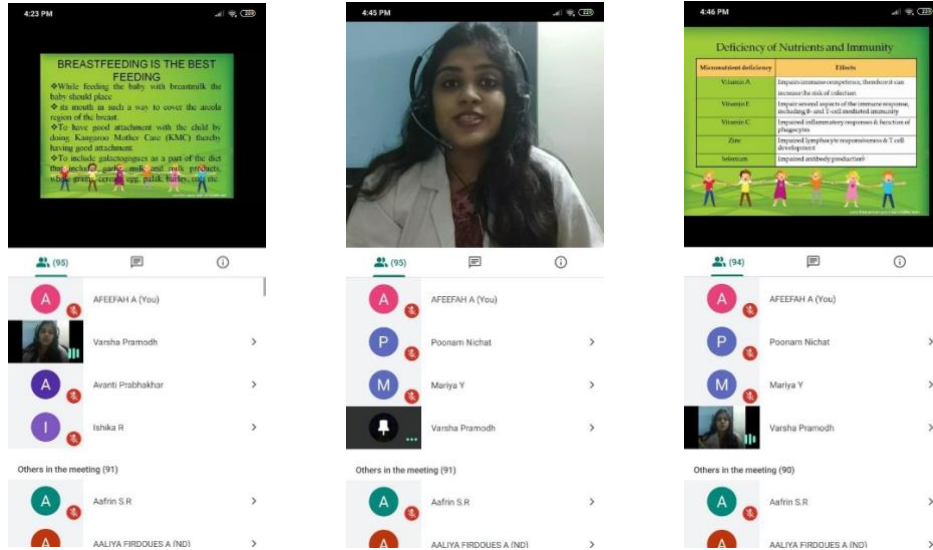


DEPARTMENT OF HOMESCIENCE (FN)

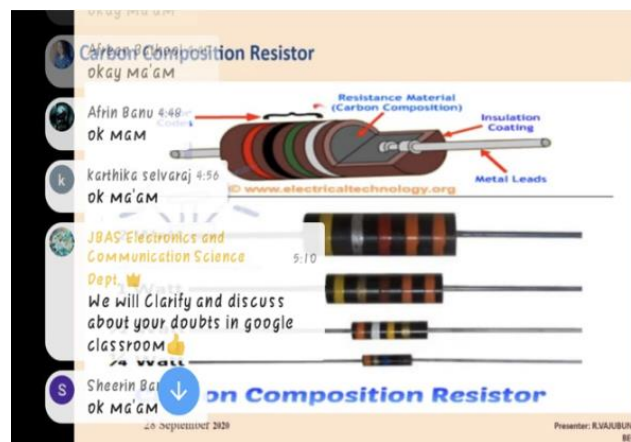

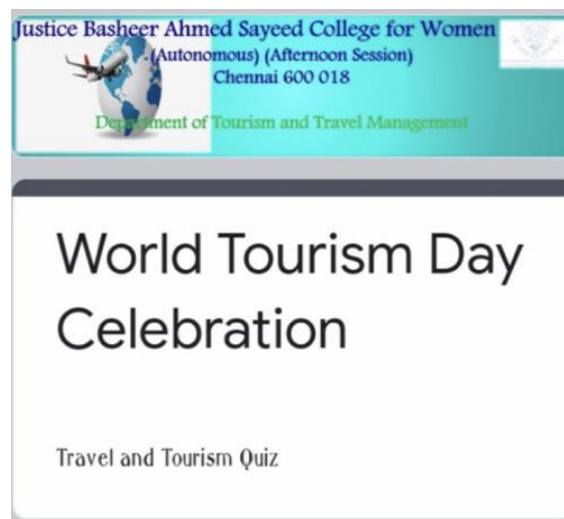
DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR DESIGN AND DECOR (AN)

And who is she, you may ask

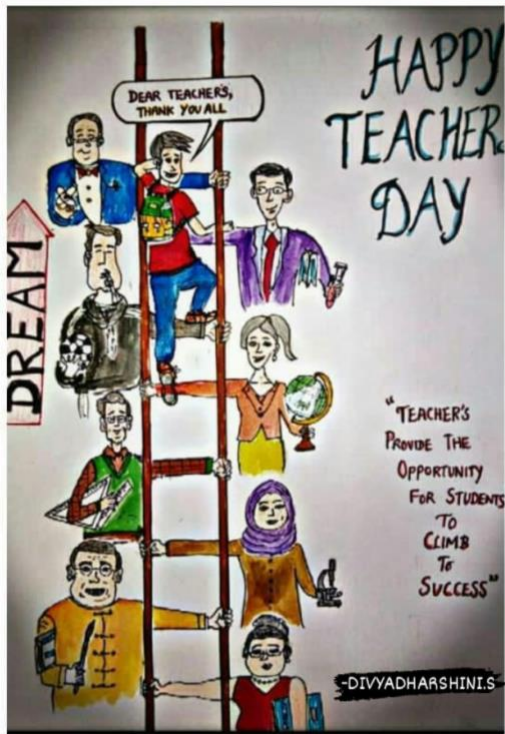
