ACTIVITIES OF IQAC FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

The activities of the IQAC for the academic year 2023-24 began with 5 day Induction programme for UG students titled ‘**Step - in**’ conducted from 3rd to 7th July 2023 in the Golden Jubilee seminar hall and College Auditorium respectively. The programme commenced by welcoming the parents in the Seminar Hall. The Principal, Dr. Amthul Azeez, addressed the gathering and informed the parents about the College. From the second day onwards sessions like **History of the College, Facilities of the College, Importance of Physical fitness, Mentoring, Health is wealth, Developing skill sets, Personality development, Social Consciousness and Values, Cyber Security, Know the vision and Mission, Know your Curriculum and Examination and Evaluation reforms** were delivered by various resource persons for both sessions in 2 venues. This year, Induction programme for Post graduate students was conducted on 17th July 2023. The sessions on History of the College, Research and Resources, Students Progression and Curriculum and Evaluation were handled by various resource persons from the college.

The IQAC conducted a meeting with the Bank Officials under the banner of Stakeholders Meet on 29th September 2023.

The IQAC organized 5 day Faculty Development Programme **ADAPT TO ADOPT Curriculum Framework – Design, Develop & Deploy** from 10th October 2023 – 4th November 2023 for the faculty of forenoon and afternoon session. The resource persons included Dr. Horne Iona Averal, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College, Tiruchirapalli and Dr. P. Shanti, Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Holy Cross College, Tiruchirapalli for Day 1 and Day 2 emphasizing on LOCF Framework – its objectives and initiatives. Also providing hands-on training added with a sample CO and PO matrix connected with a sample course curriculum gave

an in-depth understanding of the ways how COs and POs can be interlinked with the coursework and syllabus highlighting the importance of mapping PO and CO.

Dr. Gladston Xavier, Associate Professor, Department of Social Work, Loyola College, Chennai was the resource person for Day 3 for the faculty members of Art stream. The speaker discussed the concept of sustainable development and its impact on education, emphasizing the need for the education system to adapt to the changing needs of the younger generation. Day 4 FDP was conducted for the faculty members of Science stream. Dr. Gnanasambanthan, Professor (Retd.), Department of CSE, NITTTR (SR), GoI (Ministry of Education), Taramani, delivered an insightful session on the topic “Outcome Based Instructional System for Sciences”. He highlighted the Paradigm shift from Traditional Learning Education (TLE) to Outcome Based Education (OBE) emphasizing the need for a learner-centric approach with more focus on experiential learning and exploratory learning principles. Day 5 FDP was conducted for the faculty members of Commerce and Business Administration stream. Dr. Thiagrajan Ramanathan, Assistant Professor (Senior grade), PSG Institute of Management, Coimbatore. His lecture was exhaustive and covered various methods for creating, refining and implementing a framework for learning that improves competencies for the changing demands of students in society

. He highlighted a few methods to integrate ICT into the Curriculum to empower the students’ needs in a technology-driven society.

Bloom and Illuminate programme was organised by the IQAC for the Academically Below Average Students and Advanced Learners. . The resource person for Illuminate was Ms. Mridhula Aruvadai Psychological Support Service, an Alumna of our college and her team emphasized on SWOT and about a psychological technique called VARK – Visual Auditory Read/Write and Kinesthetic. The resource person for Bloom was Ms. Rekha Murali, Psychologist, gave an insight about importance of meditation and physical activities such as yoga, aerobics, walk etc helps to reduce stress and relax which in turn makes the students to concentrate in studies.

The Anti Discriminatory Cell conducted an inter-collegiate online video contest on the topic “Yaadhum oorey, yaavarum kelir” on 5th October 2023. sponsored by IQAC in the Placement Training Room. 24 students registered for the competition The videos were evaluated on the basis of concept, video editing and presentation.

The IQAC organized a transformative Outbound Training programme for the Non-teaching and Ground Staff of both forenoon and afternoon session on **10th February 2024** at the **Coral Beach Resort, Mahabalipuram**. The **theme** of the day, "**RRR - Recode: Recreate: Rejoice,**" set the tone for an enriching and engaging experience aimed at fostering teamwork, collaboration, and personal growth.

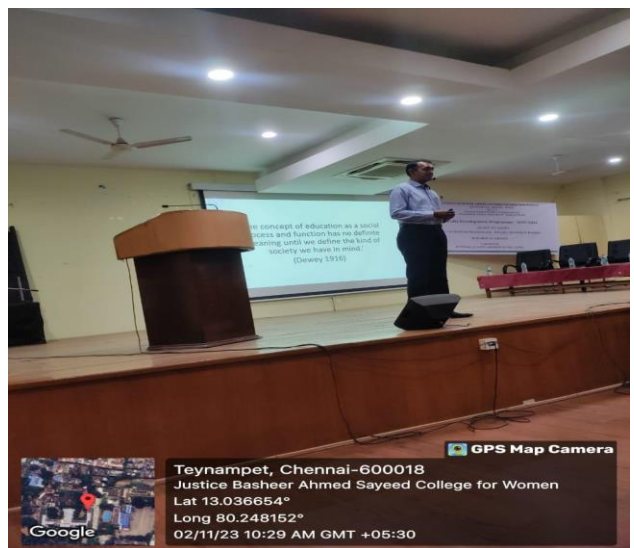
