CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CENTRE

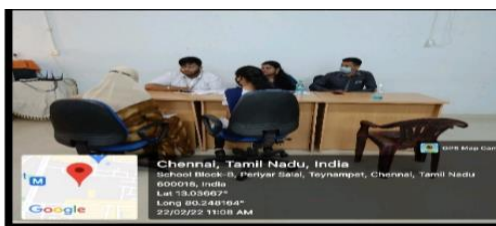
The Career Guidance and Placement Centre in collaboration with Hibiz Solutions organised a Placement Programme on 4th February, 2022 through the virtual platform



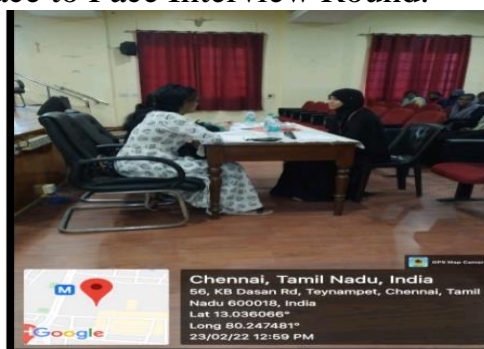

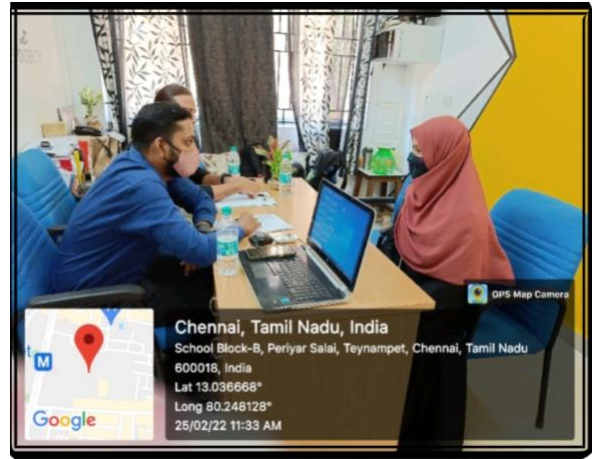
