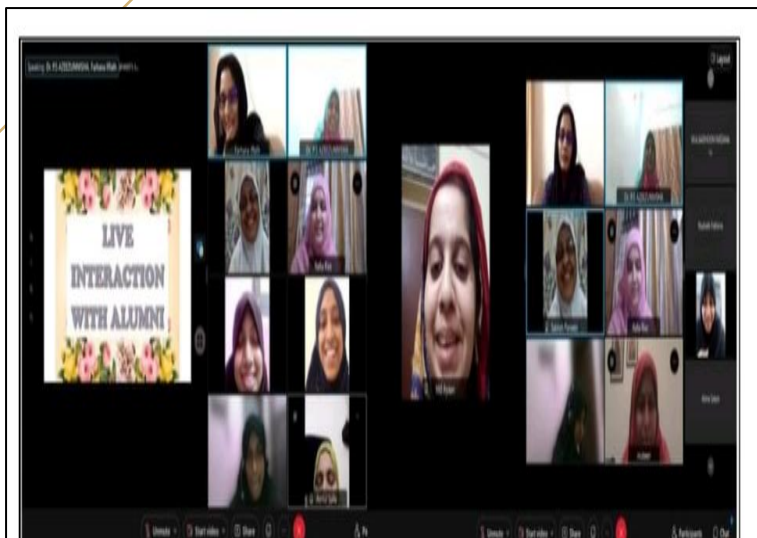

Alumnae for Day 1 were Ms.Anitha J and Ms. Aparna Kanmani.

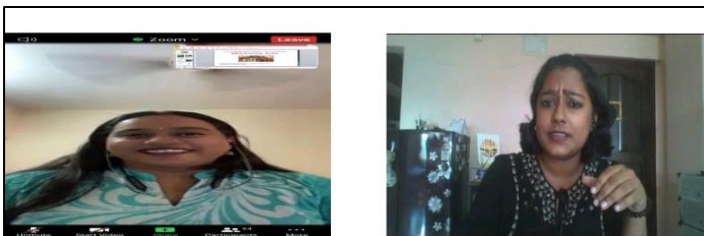

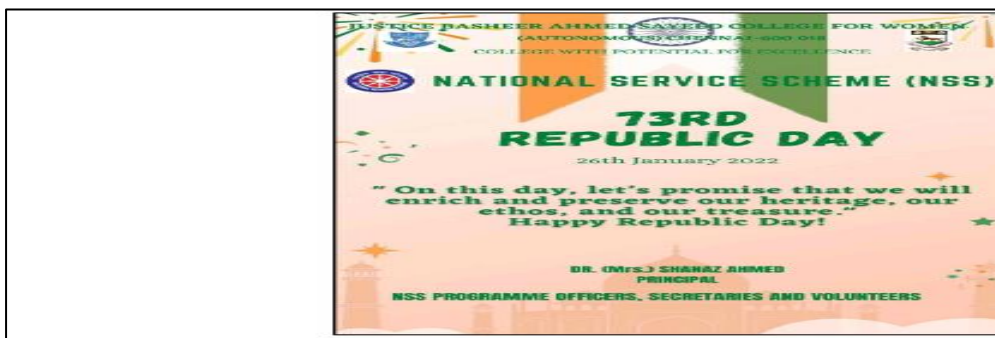
NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

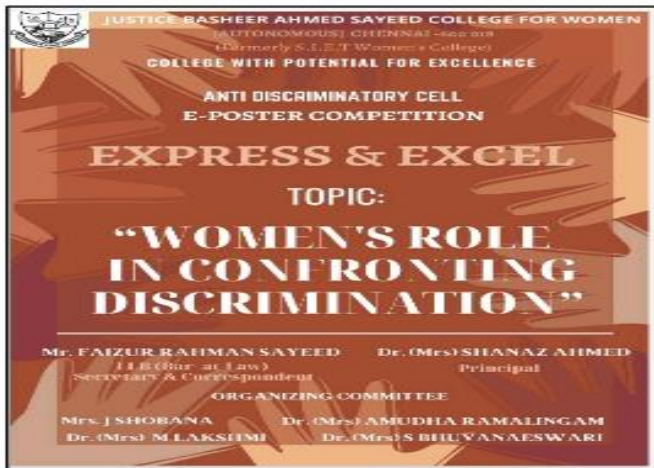

The NSS organised a grand programme on the occasion of republic day.

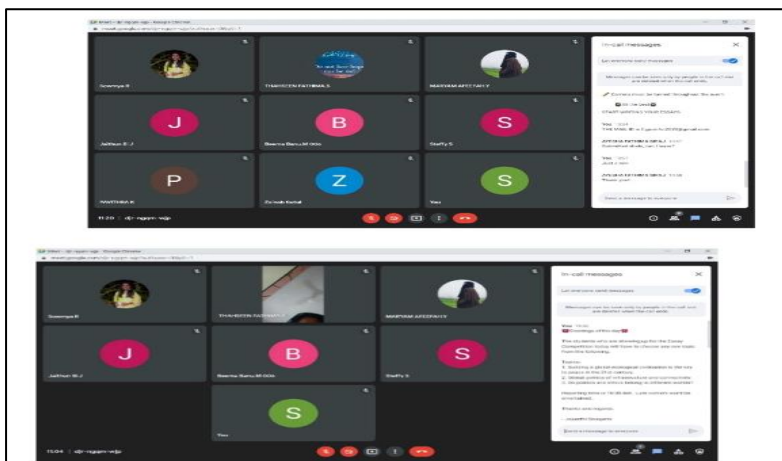

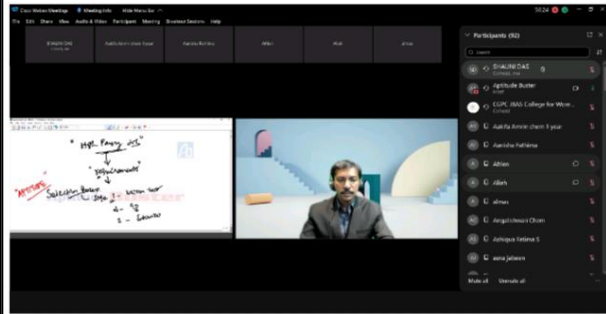
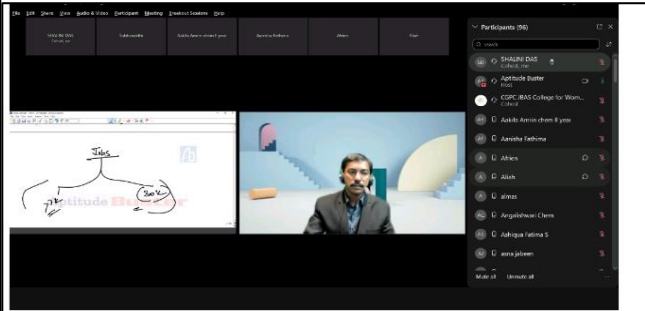
CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CENTRE

On the 3rd January 2022, the CGPC in collaboration with VISION IAS, conducted an online essay writing competition.

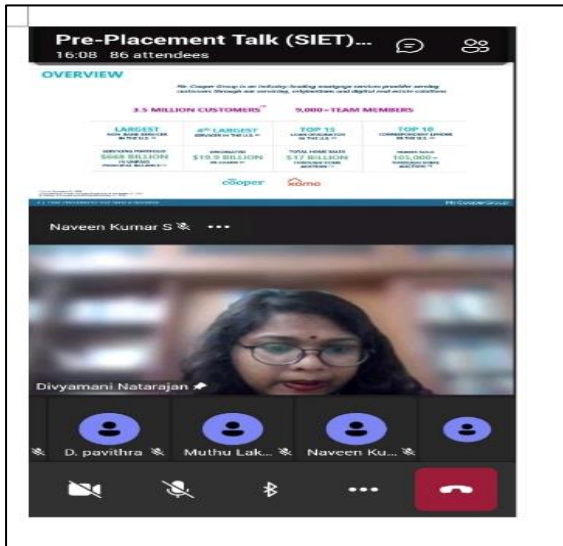

Lead me to stand under the hotness of fire

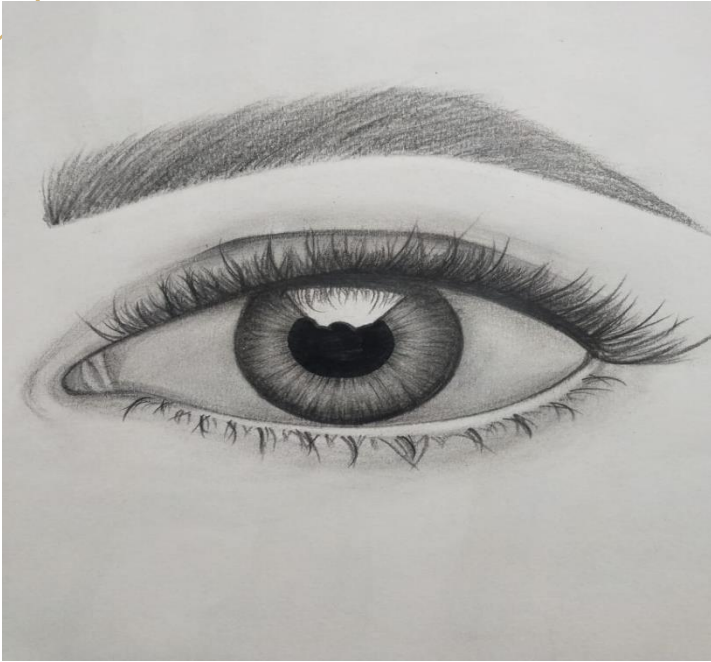
