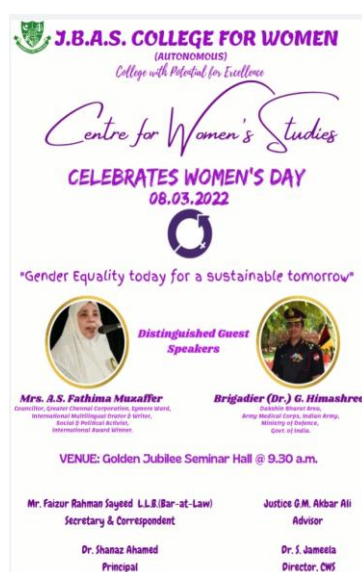

CENTRE FOR WOMEN'S STUDIES

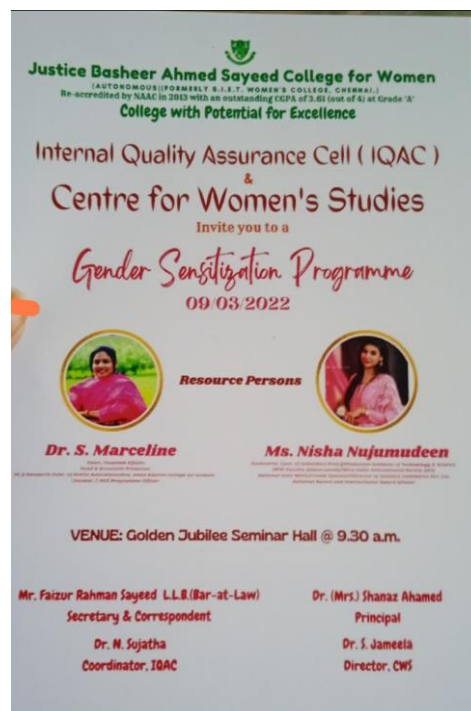

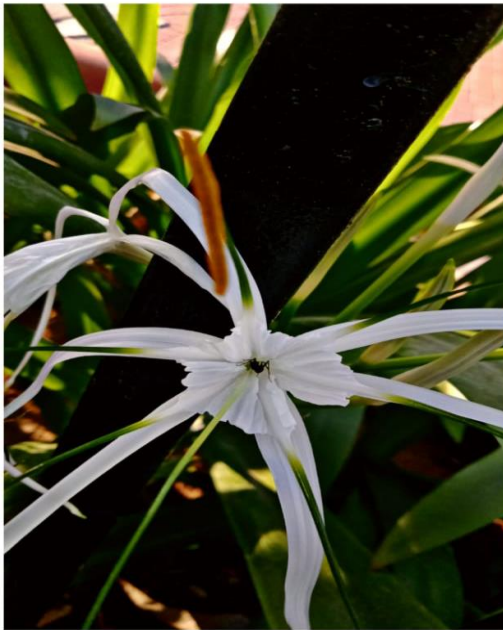
