








FRESHERS' EVE '23

ANIMATION FILM:




On the 3rd day food event





INAUGURATION OF BIOCHEMISTRY ASSOCIATION 2023



DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS INAUGURATION OF ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION 2023



PG AND RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH. INAUGURAL MEET OF THE ENGLISH ASSOCIATION 2023




